We cannot live as Christians without participating in the Sacrifice of the Cross in which the Lord Jesus gives himself unreservedly to save, by his death, humanity which had died because of sin; the Redeemer associates humanity with himself and leads it back to the Father; in the embrace of the Crucified One all human suffering finds light and comfort.

The first Spiritan to step foot in England was Fr. Jacques Bertout, from France. A refugee from the persecution of the Church during the French Revolution, he arrived on 19th September, 1792 and immediately began missionary work here until he was able to return to France in 1802.

The permanent establishment of the Congregation in England was in 1904 in the Diocese of Clifton when a large property called Prior Park was rented.

We welcome Fr Brendan Ona to all the Masses this weekend.

Spiritans have enjoyed some great missionary successes and expansion in Britain and overseas, and have maintained an international and missionary flavour to their works.

Spiritans of the British Province work in Britain and many parts of the world. In 2017 their overseas mission works are largely in South Africa, Brussels, Italy, Nigeria and the USA

In the UK we have over 50 Spiritans working in Youth, Refugee, Prison, Hospital and Parish ministries. Many work as Parish priests, development workers, chaplains, retreat and spiritual directors.
