Advent 2023 - The start of the **Year of Prayer**

The Year of Prayer is not a year *about* prayer, but a year *for* prayer. The image of Christ in the manger speaks of a God who wants an intimate relationship with His creation. Advent will see initiatives that parishes can start engaging

Archbishop Bernard Longley calls on everyone to take part in this Year:

"The Year of Prayer starts on the first Sunday of Advent (3rd Dec). Pope Francis desires to see the Our Father become the "life programme" of every disciple, and so I invite our Diocesan family to prepare for the Jubilee Year, "Pilgrims of Hope", through a deeper devotion to prayer in this Year of Prayer! "At our recent Bishops' Conference meeting, we resolved to work towards a renewal of our adoration of Jesus Christ and our service of neighbour. I pray that our Lord will guide us to become a more synodal, missionary and prayerful Church, as we approach the Holy Year."

Why the 'Year of Prayer?'

In preparation for the Jubilee Year "Pilgrims of Hope", 2023-24 has been designated the Year of Prayer by Pope Francis, with a particular emphasis on the Our Father. This presents our Church with a significant opportunity to revisit the basics of prayer, and for us to become even more a people of prayer. Someone once said that 'prayer doesn't help our relationship with God, prayer IS our relationship with God!' and so when we become more devoted to prayer, we are building up that Divine friendship. Being Pilgrims of Hope means that we should always be growing in our love of prayer on our journey of Faith. But the Year of Prayer also asks us to consider how we might help others to pray, so that they can experience a personal encounter with the risen Jesus.

RORATE CAELI MASS – THIS SATURDAY AT 7:00AM

"Rorate, caeli, desuper, et nubes pluant justum, aperiatur terra, et germinet Salvatorem."

"Drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain the just: let the earth be opened and bud forth a Saviour."

The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight. Because it is a votive Mass in Mary's honour, white vestments are worn instead of Advent violet. In the dimly lit setting, priests and faithful prepare to honour the Light of the world, Who is soon to be born, and offer praise to God for the gift of Our Lady. As the Mass proceeds and sunrise approaches, the church becomes progressively brighter, illumined by the sun as our Faith is illumined by Christ.

The readings and prayers of the Mass foretell the prophecy of the Virgin who would bear a Son called Emmanuel, and call on all to raise the gates of their hearts and their societies to let Christ the King enter; asking for the grace to receive eternal life by the merits of the Incarnation and saving Resurrection of Our Lord.

CHRISTMAS EVE - SUNDAY 24th

The Masses for the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ will begin in the afternoon of Christmas Eve, these are not the Sunday Masses of the Fourth Sunday of Advent – beginning with the Vigil Mass at 3:30pm. A priest is only allowed to say a maximum of three Masses in any given 24 hour period and for this reason there will be NO Mass at 9:00am am the morning of the 24th of December. In order to fulfil the Sunday obligation you will have to go to the Saturday evening Vigil Mass at 5:30pm or the Sunday Solemn Mass at 11:00am (or Masses at other times in other Churches). It is always difficult when Christmas Day is next to a Sunday. In order to remain in a state of grace one has to go to the Mass for Advent and then straight away to the Christmas Mass.
