Syria-Turkey earthquake: What has happened?

In the early hours of Monday 6 February 2023, a powerful 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck near Turkey's border with northern Syria.

The scale of the devastation remains unclear. But we know that the earthquake has already killed more than 11,000 people, injured hundreds more and destroyed thousands of homes and buildings.

After the earthquake, 42 aftershocks occurred with the largest of a 6.6 magnitude. Millions of people across Turkey, Syria, Lebanon, Cyprus and Israel felt the earthquake.
