THE HOLY ROSARY

The Rosary Helps us Grow in Holiness

After the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, the Holy Rosary is the prayer most pleasing to Our Lady.

Why is it so pleasing to her? Because it brings us closer to Jesus.

That is the single most important reason we should pray the Holy Rosary: through it, we grow closer to Our Lord.

In fact, this spiritual growth is an "automatic" benefit of praying the Rosary: one cannot recite the Rosary without growing in holiness—at least in small ways. Over time, consistent recitation of the Rosary is a guaranteed way to become the saint God want you to be.

"If you say the Rosary faithfully until death, I do assure you that, in spite of the gravity of your sins, you shall receive a never fading crown of glory. For even if you are now on the brink of damnation, even if you have one foot in hell, even if you have sold your soul to the devil...sooner or later you will be converted and will amend your life and save your soul. If—you say the Rosary devoutly every day of your life." *St. Louis de Montfort*
