Veneration of picture, Litany of Divine Mercy, Examination of Conscience, Spiritual Confession, Benediction

Our Divine Mercy Novena began on Good Friday and concludes on this, Divine Mercy Sunday. The intentions for the remaining days of this Novena are given here:

Day 8: Today bring Me the souls in purgatory. They are greatly loved by Me. It is in your power to bring them relief. Draw from the indulgences of My Church.

Day 9: Today bring Me the souls who have become lukewarm. For them, the last hope of salvation is to flee to My Mercy.

The chaplet of Divine Mercy should be prayed daily in this Novena. It can be prayed using ordinary Rosary Beads. Begin with: Our Father..., Hail Mary..., The Apostles' Creed. On the five large beads say: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world. On the ten small beads say: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion Have mercy on us and on the whole world. Conclude with (three times): Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Second Week of Easter Monday, April 20th - Friday, April 24th - from 6:30pm, Evening Prayer of the Church, Divine Mercy Chaplet, Mass (7.00pm), Rosary, Night Prayer. Saturday, April 25th., Evening Prayer of the Church, 5pm, Mass of the 3rd. Sunday of Easter, 5.30pm, followed by Rosary and Night Prayer of the Church.

Sunday, April 26th., 3rd. Sunday of Easter, Mass 10.30am, Holy Hour and Benediction, 5.30pm.
