THE FEAST OF THE CHAIR OF SAINT PETER

The "chair" to which this feast refers is the cathedra, or office, of the Apostle Peter. Given by Christ to Saint Peter and represents his supreme pastoral office which is passed to each of his successors as the Bishop of Rome, that is, where Saint Peter last served and where he died a martyr.

"And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock, I will build my Church, and the powers of death shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."

On this day let us particularly pray for our Holy Father Pope Francis that God may give him health and strength to guide and govern His holy people.

And so the parishes that adore the Lord are the ones that grow and flourish because they are spiritually healthy. There will soon be information and all of the times of Adoration in the Cluster.
