RETURNING TO MASS AT PENTECOST

An invitation from the Bishops of England and Wales. *This is the bread come down from heaven (John 6:58)* Copies of the letter are available at the back of church please take. Attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days is the greatest of all privileges, sometimes referred to as "the Sunday Obligation." The pressing challenges of the pandemic have lessened significantly. Most people have resumed the wide range of normal activities, no longer restricted by the previous Covid measures. We therefore believe that the reasons which have prevented Catholics from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation no longer apply. With humility, we glory in being a Eucharistic people for whom attendance at Mass is essential.

THE VIGIL MASS OF PENTECOST

The Pentecost Vigil like the "mother of all vigils," as Saint Augustine referred to Easter Vigil, includes an extended number of readings and texts that reflect a particular aspect of the Paschal mystery.

As the Easter Vigil presents seven Old Testament readings to contemplate the presence of Christ's Paschal mystery throughout salvation history, The Vigil Mass for Pentecost presents four readings to communicate that same mystery with an emphasis on the working of the Holy Spirit.

"Lord, send forth your Spirit and renew the face of the earth"



Queen of Heaven, rejoice, alleluia. For He whom you did merit to bear, alleluia. Has risen, as he said, alleluia. Pray for us to God, alleluia.

V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.
R. For the Lord has truly risen, alleluia.
Let us pray. O God, who gave joy to the world through the resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, grant we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may obtain the joys of everlasting life. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.
